HOW TO BE A **DISABILITY ALLY:**

Be there for young wheelchair users with these seven tips from Whizz Kidz

1. Listen to disabled people: respect their views and experiences. Don't assume you know what's best for them.

2. Respect boundaries: ask permission before offering help. Respect people and let them make their own choices.

3. Use respectful language: avoid language that's offensive to disabled people. If you're unsure, ask them.

4. Take action: use your voice and actively support disability rights in your community, school, workplace and personal life.

5. Be inclusive: actively invite and accomodate disabled people in social activities, events and discussions.

6. Challenge ableism: speak out against ableist language and attitudes. Educate others about why it's hurtful or harmful.

7. Be an ally, not a hero: recognise that you are not a saviour but a partner in creating a more inclusive society for disabled people.

EPIC ACCESSIBLE **ADVENTURE TIPS**

See Morph in style with these top travel tips from Whizz Kidz's young wheelchair users.

1. Always book assistance when travelling by train or tube if you think you will need it.

2. Charge ALL your devices before you leave. Don't get stranded because your battery died.

3. Use a journey planner. Plan your route before and check on the day for any closures.

4. Take a photo of your route in case you lose signal for your map app or are on the tube.

5. Check your brakes before using public transport to avoid them coming loose.

6. Use an app to show step-free routes practice with the app before you go.

7. Allow time for longer step-free routes. Stations may be far from the sights you want

8. Do a virtual tour of your route with Google Street view or similar to ensure it is step-free.

9. Don't be shy to ask staff for help. They want to assist you (and are used to London's tourists!)

10. Have your head on a swivel! Many people will be looking at Morph, their phone and the sights - not where they are going.

Our vision is for a society in which every young wheelchair user is mobile enab and included.


